Registration Information

FESTIVAL DATE & VENUE

- Friday, March 25, 2022
- Liberty Church | 495 Hartford Turnpike | Shrewsbury, MA 01545

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

- All Fine Arts Participant Online Registration Forms and fees must be **submitted by February 23, 2022**.
- General Attendees must register online at www.snemn.com/student-ministries. Online Registration will be open before and during the event. All General Attendees must check-in to receive an event pass.

REGISTRATION FEES

- \$45/participant – includes one category
- \$15/each additional category. There is a limit of 7 categories per participant.
- All registration fees are non-refundable.
- All fees are to be paid online. After each parent completes the Fine Arts Participant Online Participant Registration Form, an email will be sent to the Youth Leader for final signature and final approval. Please make sure payment amounts are accurate and participant/group information is accurate before final submission.
- This registration does not include meals and lodging. Groups and individuals are responsible to secure their own accommodations if they require them.
- There is no fee for General Attendees, however they are required to register online.

HOW TO REGISTER

- Each parent should **Complete the 2022 SNEMN Fine Arts Festival Online Registration Form** for participants only. The form will be sent to the Youth Leader for final approval before submission. All forms must be submitted by February 23, 2022.
- *A confirmation letter will be sent to the Youth/FA Leader to confirm the participant registration is received.*
- **Writing entries** must be submitted as one .doc or .pdf during the online registration process by February 23, 2022.
- **Short Film & Promo Video entries** must be submitted as a listed or unlisted YouTube URL by email during the online registration process by February 23, 2022.

ON-SITE CHECK-IN INFORMATION

- Fine Arts Festival On-Site Check-In will be from **8:00 am – 9:00 am**. All participant and General attendees are required to check-in.
- *Participant Orientation begins at 9:15 am. The 1st presentation begins at approximately 10:00 am.*
- All **Art Category entries** must be hand-delivered to the Art Gallery between 8:00 am – 9:00 am upon completing On-Site Check-In on March 25th, 2022.
