



Annual Network Business Meeting 2021

FAQS

1. Who should register for the Annual Network Business Meeting?

All SNEMN credentialed ministers (certified, licensed, ordained) and delegates are eligible to vote and are encouraged to register for the business meeting.

2. When Does Registration Close?

Registration will close on Wednesday May 12th at 10:00PM.

3. If my spouse and I are both credential holders, do we need to register separately?

Yes! If both you and your spouse are credential holders, you will both need to uniquely register for the business meeting. Once registered, each of you will be sent (via email) your own unique log in link.

4. If my spouse and I are both credential holders and share the same email, what do we do?

In order to uniquely vote at the business meeting, you must register with a unique email address. If you and your spouse share an email, one of you will need to utilize a different email address to register and make sure to check that email for your confirmation and login information for the meeting.

5. When will I receive my confirmation email?

Immediately after you register, you should have received a confirmation email with your login information for the business meeting. If you did not receive that confirmation, please contact Chris Hurtado at Chris@snemn.com.

As a courtesy, we will resend all confirmation emails to our registered guests on Monday May 17, 2021.

6. How many delegates do I receive?

Churches of 1-100 members receive 1 delegate
Churches of 101+ members receive 2 delegates

All delegates must register for the business meeting.

7. How do I vote at the Business Meeting?

Once you have 1. Registered, 2. Received your confirmation email 3. Log into the meeting on a unique device, then you will be able to vote electronically from your device during the meeting.

**Please note, if you are tuning into the business meeting with other credential holders, each credential holder must be logged into their own unique device to vote.
