8 felt it necessary to develop a new set of Bylaws, and,

- 10 WHEREAS, These Bylaws have been presented to every Section for conversation, questions
11 and input, and,

- 13 WHEREAS, The input from these Sectional meetings have been considered by the Presbytery
14 in the overall structure of the Bylaws, and,

- 16 WHEREAS, To consider the Bylaws line by line would take away from the overall effort of
17 these past years, and,

- 19 WHEREAS, Government guidelines and *Roberts Rules of Order* only call for one guiding
20 document, therefore,

- 22 BE IT RESOLVED, That the current Constitution and Bylaws of the Southern New England
23 Ministry Network be set aside, and,

- 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the new Bylaws, presented at the 2020 Annual
26 Network Meeting, be adopted as a whole, and,

- 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That during the implementation process, the current
29 Presbyter board will serve as the acting Executive
30 Presbytery until the new Executive Presbytery is elected,

- 32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That implementation progress updates be presented before
33 the 2021 Annual Network Meeting.
