SUMMER CAMP FAQ

Is camp a week long this year?

This year camp will be 4 days. Monday through Thursday.

Where is camp located?

Camp is located at 31 Gilford Ave, Rumney, NH 03266

What time is pick-up and drop off?

Junior High Camp:

Drop off – Monday, June 28th at 1–3pm

Pickup – Thursday, July 1st at 1:00pm

Senior High Camp:

Drop off – Monday, July 5th at 1–3pm

Pickup – Thursday, July 8th at 1:00pm

What is the capacity limit for campers?

Our capacity for camp each week for the 2021 season is 150 students.

Do I have to get a COVID test before attending camp?

A negative Covid-19 test is recommended, but not required.

Do I have to be vaccinated in order to attend camp?

No vaccination is required to attend SNE Ministry Network Camps.

What COVID safety precautions will SNEMN make at camp?

We will be following the State of New Hampshire's Covid-19 guidelines that will be in place during the time of camp.

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COVID-19 EVENT PROTOCOLS



Screening - All participants must be screened for COVID-19 exposure prior to traveling to or upon arrival to SNEMN events using the questionnaire available on page three of this document. Each person is required to complete the form within twenty-four hours prior to arriving or upon arrival to an event. Completed forms will be collected upon arrival to any event. **If a participant answers yes to any of the questions on the COVID-19 questionnaire, they should not attend in person. Some of our events may be available online.**



Medical Personnel - A nurse will be on site to oversee temperature screenings, COVID-19 questions and medical issues (applicable to large events).



Temperature Checks - All participants may be asked to submit to a touch-less temperature check upon arrival at the event. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher will be isolated for further medical evaluation.



Masks Required - In the spirit of cooperation with government authorities, masks will be required in all public indoor spaces. Children under 6 are exempt from wearing a mask.

Mask Guidelines & Exceptions:

- While eating or drinking
- Outdoors when socially distanced
- Difficulty breathing
- In individual lodging
- While swimming
- Certain medical conditions*

*Masks are not required for any person who cannot wear a mask due to a medical condition, including those with respiratory issues that impede breathing, mental health condition, or disability. No proof of conditions is required.



Cohorts/Teams - Participants are strongly encouraged to remain with the cohort they are assigned at the start of camp. Each cohort should plan to stay together when possible for the duration of the event.



Altar-in-Place - The altar is located where you and your group are located. Remain in place with your group and pray together during altar and prayer times.



On-Site Food Service - Participants should stay with their groups during meals. Groups should be seated to maintain distancing.



Sanitizer Stations - Hand sanitizer stations will be available throughout the event.

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COVID-19 DISCLAIMER AND QUESTIONNAIRE

Each participant must complete this form before leaving for any SNEMN Event

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is a contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and those with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable. By attending SNE Ministry Network events, I voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19. I understand that some activities may not follow traditional social distancing.

Each participant may be asked to submit to a touch-less temperature check upon arrival at the event. Anyone with a temperature 100.4 degrees or higher will be isolated for further medical evaluation. **I understand that if I develop symptoms of COVID-19 while at the event, I may be sent to a testing site to be checked for COVID-19, and I also understand that I may be asked to leave the event prior to receiving COVID-19 test results.**

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, some SNE Ministry Network events are categorized at the highest risk level. **Highest Risk is defined by the CDC as:** Individuals mix between groups and do not remain spaced apart. Individuals attending are not from the local geographic area (e.g., community, town, city, county or state).

I understand that if I answer yes to any of the questions below, I will not attend the event in person.

1. Have you tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days? **YES** **NO**
2. Have you knowingly had contact with anyone who, in the last 14 days, has tested positive for COVID-19? **YES** **NO**
3. Have you had the combination of these symptoms in the past 14 days? **YES** **NO**
 - Fever of 100.4 or higher (without fever reducing medication)
 - Feeling feverish (chills, sweating)
 - New cough
 - Difficulty breathing
 - Sore throat
 - Muscle aches or body aches
 - Vomiting or diarrhea
 - New loss of taste or smell
