



PRAYER POINTS

The pastor can lead in prayer, or invite (in advance) students, teachers, coaches, and/or administrators from within the congregation to pray. Be Creative, and engage those in attendance.

> PRAY FOR STUDENTS

Adjusting back to in-person learning—waking up earlier, interactions with peers and teachers, hours away from home, etc.—may be difficult for some students.

Recovery from learning gap for those whose grades have fallen.

Students who enjoyed and excelled in online learning to transition well.

> PRAY FOR FAMILIES OF STUDENTS

Parents who have lost jobs and are having a hard time getting hired.

Unity and social support for students.

Healing & Restoration from unhealthy habits and unsafe environments.

> PRAY FOR TEACHERS AND STAFF

Teachers and other support staff face anxieties with students being back in the room.

Increased patience and creative classroom management.

> PRAY FOR COACHES

New seasons for players and coaches—shifting regulations.

Safety of all involved in athletic competitions.

Meaningful connections between coaches and mentors, and students.

Grace with students focusing on mental health

> PRAY FOR ADMINISTRATORS

School Committees have very difficult decisions to make—pray for wisdom in decision making, communication, and united vision.

Pray for the Mayor and Superintendent of schools as they lead through rapid change.
